Presentations summarizing the scoping process will be held at 5:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.

The scoping meeting kicks off Phase II of the Alternatives Analysis and will allow public comments to assist the KCATA and the City of Kansas City, Missouri in determining the purpose and need for action, alternatives and issues that need to be considered in its Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) for the Federal Transit Administration (FTA).

The DEIS officially opens the next phase of the federal funding process and is prepared in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) to assess the environmental and community impacts of transit improvements.
